The year is 2007 and the public is tired of paying for an out of control prison system. The answer . . . Outlaw Island. A prison paradise? No Way! Now YOU and your fellow inmates are marooned on a remote island, and need to fight rival prison mobs for some of the most disgusting food on the planet.

The "NUKE"

Death Valley, Black Hills, Wounded Knee, The Outpost, Horse Shoe, Deadwood, and The Peak. The team that conquers the most territories by the end of the game, wins! Each Territory has a flag station with a Red and Blue flag. Your Mission: To "Command and Conquer" The Badlands, by capturing more territories than you opponents. Each time you capture a territory, raise your flag, as your opponents flag comes down.

Think your done? Not a chance!

Now that you've captured a territory, your team needs to go further and try to capture more. But! Which territories are already in the hands of the enemy? Should you send out a spy to find out? Should you just organize another platoon to "move out" and try to capture another one? Should you leave some defenders to hold the territory you just captured? If you do leave defenders, how many?
